Some Answers To Your Stewardship Questions

What time period am I pledging for?

Your pledge is an annual pledge covering the coming twelve month period, and continuing until the next stewardship campaign in 2012.

When should I begin contributions based on my pledge?

Please adjust your Offertory contributions to reflect your new pledge as soon as it has been submitted.

Why must I return a pledge form?

Your stewardship pledge allows St. Bridget Parish to thoroughly plan and manage the resources of the parish. Even though you make contributions during the Offertory, your Stewardship pledge communicates your giving intentions to the parish. This is critical information for the financial operations of the parish, including the allocation of resources for the support of our many ministries.

What are the goals for the Stewardship Campaign?

The Stewardship Campaign has three goals, each important to the financial stability of our parish:

- + To receive a pledge commitment from all parishioners to be financial stewards of our parish
- + To increase overall giving within the parish to meet our growing financial challenges, and,
- + To obtain the commitment of all parishioners to fulfill their pledges within the stewardship year.

What should I consider as my stewardship pledge?

Your pledge should be a personal act of faith based on your individual or family circumstances and resources. You should generously participate in the Annual Stewardship Commitment campaign by making a financial promise to God based on all that He gives you. Each individual and family is encouraged to decide on a pledge that is meaningful and reflects God's blessings on your family. If every parishioner - family or individual - made a stewardship pledge with these thoughts in mind, we will be successful in meeting the needs of our parish, our ministries, and our human concerns commitments.
