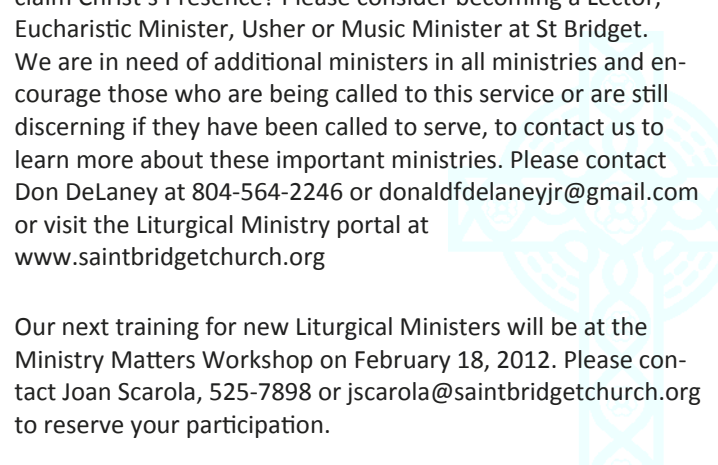
Knights Appreciation

Where did Jesus' sense of justice come from? As a good Jew, he learned from the Hebrew Scriptures. The Office of Justice and Peace and Richmond Area Parish Social Ministers invite you to explore justice within the Hebrew Scriptures. Justice in the Hebrew Scriptures is different than the legalistic justice that dominates our American culture. The Hebrew Scriptures present justice to us from the point of view of our God. It is this sense of justice that is at the root of Catholic Social Teaching.
