- 1. Opening Prayer-Adsumus, Sancte Spiritus from the Synod
- 2. Minutes from August 17, 2022 Meeting-Minutes approved
- 3. Reports from Liaisons:

• Faith Formation - Mack Rich

- -Mona is looking for 6 volunteers for CLOW and 4 additional Faith Formation volunteers
- -Patrick Stearman is looking for volunteers for youth and high school ministry; theme for the year: Visions of Blessed Community; he is happy to meet with any Parish Council members as he's trying to get to know more parishioners
- -Mona is moving off staff and the position will be advertised

• Liturgy Committee - Fran Wagner

- -Ministry Matters Oct. 6 specific to liturgical ministers for training
- -Beginning to look at Christmas Mass schedule: 5:00 pm (church), 5:30 pm (MPH); 8:00 (church), Midnight mass (church); 9:00 am

- -Monthly feeding ministries going on

- -Pere Pierre from Haiti visit in October to coincide with Haiti Pen Pals with school

4. Mass Schedule - Recap & Contingency Plan

Contingency Plan created by Fr. Ken in case St. Bridget is assigned only 1
priest. No further discussion amongst parish council members regarding
the contingency plan and no vote taken by parish council at this time.

- -Father Ken shared data on priest assignments throughout the diocese regarding how many priests have multiple parishes
- -4 new priests available in June with 8-9 retirements
- -St. Bridget's is one of eight parishes that have multiple priests
- -Church needs to be proactive on helping community understand the challenge in the diocese
- -Church must evangelize and bring people back to demonstrate the need for two priests and pray for current and future seminarians
- -Dan Harms currently in new position of Director of Evangelization to help in this endeavor

5. Parish Directory-Report from Ron Campbell

- -Ron expressed concern when speaking with the staff; Current staff concerns include security of personal information with prevalence of phishing scams
- -Ron met with representative of the company; 20 minute sittings with photographer; electronic option with an app and ability to make donations using the app
- -Need to determine how to contact 2000 parishioners (email, phone calls, mass letters mailed?)
- -Father Ken sees this as an evangelization opportunity that needs to happen to reach out to people who have not come back
- -Dave suggested reaching out to another parish in the diocese who has been through this process recently for troubleshooting purposes
- -Appointments can be made online or appointments can be made for those not comfortable with scheduling online
- -November 2-5 and November 9-12 for possible photo sessions and overflow dates available

5. Diocesan Synod Report & Parish Synopsis

- -Diocese published report recently
- -Father Ken created list of action items based on parishioner responses
- -Many action items have been implemented and will continue to be implemented
- -USCCB site published national report
- -Continental responses to follow

6. Youth Faith Formation/Ministry Visioning Meeting (8/9/22) & Catholic Heart Work Camp

-Forum held in August with Andrew Waring (Director of Evangelization for diocese and parishioner) who facilitated this discussion

- -387 registered active Catholic ages 14-17; 123 people participating in some form of Saint Bridget religious education meaning 68% not receiving formal religious education
- -56% of 11-13 active Catholics not receiving formal religious education
- -40% of elementary age students not receiving formal religious education
- -Father in conversations with Patrick Stearman to reach these groups
- -Pieces from programs will be utilized instead of a formal program
- -This year: religious education K-8 at 10:30 on Sundays; HS group will meet in evenings after Sunday Mass
- -Tara asked about Sunday night Mass being geared towards the youth with their participation as lectors, Extraordinary Minister, etc.; Father would like to see this at every Mass
 - -To encourage participation, Father invites newly Confirmed youth to participate in ministries
 - -Catholic Heart Work Camp expected to continue as hosts in June and Patrick will also offer 3 possible trips (one as CHWC) in the summer

7. Options for Parishioners to Contact PC Members (E-mail/Comment Box) & Posting Agenda/Meeting Minutes

- -Email account for Katie to check to be created by staff
- -Possible suggestion box in Commons; Patrick volunteered to create new Suggestion Box to sit on table under Council pictures; Mack suggested using a Google form
- -On the Monday before meetings, the agenda can go out to the parish community; Meeting Minutes to be made public on the church website
- -Tara expressed concern that parishioners are not getting emails; directions were given to tell people how to receive emails from the church website
